



Georgia CEC Paraprofessional of the Year Award 2011

The Council for Exceptional Children (CEC), the largest international professional organization for special educators, works to improve the educational success of individuals with disabilities and/or gifts and talents.

The Paraprofessional of the Year Award recognizes a paraprofessional who currently provides direct services to students with exceptionalities. The Paraprofessional of the Year is an outstanding member of the profession whose work exemplifies the best in special education support. His or her work reflects significant educational success for students, continued professional development, and the highest standards of educational quality.

Nominations may be made by a CEC unit or chapter, individual (principal, CEC member, fellow teacher/colleague, student, parent, self), educational organization (school, parent group, etc.), or community group.

Eligibility Requirements

The nominee:

- Must currently participate as a member of a teaching team providing services to Georgia students with exceptionalities.
- May be a Paraprofessional who works with students with exceptionalities within inclusive or special education settings.
- Must exhibit exemplary personal and professional skills in supporting students with exceptionalities.
- Work must be consistent with CEC's Mission Statement.
- Need not be a member of CEC.

Rules and Instructions for Nomination

- Nominees may be nominated by a CEC unit or chapter, individual (principal, CEC member, fellow teacher/colleague, student, parent, self), educational organization

(school, parent group, etc.), or community group. Only one nomination will be accepted from each CEC unit.

- The nomination packet is divided into four sections. To facilitate review, the nomination packet should be organized as follows:

Section I. Completed nomination form

Section II. Up to three letters of recommendation from colleagues, supervisors, or other professionals documenting the nominee's efforts in meeting the award criteria

Section III. Three testimonials from students, parents, or colleagues of the nominee's ability to inspire students

- **All nomination packets must be submitted electronically.** Forms containing signatures such as the nominator form, letters of recommendation and testimonials, must be scanned and sent electronically. Submit all forms as a packet by email to Sandra Macdonald at Sandra.macdonald@walton.k12.ga.us
- **Nomination packets must be received by December 1, 2010.**
